**The VITA program is a service of United Way of Saginaw County**

Free income tax assistance is provided at several locations in Saginaw County to those who cannot pay for tax preparation.

Trained and certified volunteers will prepare simple tax forms beginning the end of January through April 15 for any low-income individual, elderly, handicapped and Spanish speaking residents.
